tribute to Frank Zappa



"Make a Jazz Noise Here" is the title of one of the best-known records by the American composer-guitarist Frank ZAPPA, worshipped by avant-garde pop musicians of the 60s, 70s, and 80s.

His unclassifiable artistic profile and transgressive aesthetics have inspired us to create a show including those works which resonate with our metallic voice, enhanced by electroacoustic elements and a drum set. Seduced by his limitless creative imagination, which was influenced by such disparate artists as Edgar Varèse and Pierre Boulez as well as jazz and R & B, it has been impossible for us to escape the powerful temptation of his universe.

More than word-play, "Make a BRAZZ Noise Here" is also an experimental pretext for us to intensely enjoy living his music, his message, and his unique view of late twentieth century art. For this appealing show we are joined by famous and much admired collaborators, percussionist David Xirgu and guitarist Dani Flors.

Spanish Brass



With a thirty year trajectory in the world of chamber music, Spanish Brass is one of the most dynamic and consolidated quintets on the international musical stage.

In 1996 the ensemble won First Prize in the Sixth International Brass Quintet Competition “Ville de Narbonne” (France), considered the most prestigious for this formation. In 2017 they received First Prize in the Bankia Awards for Musical Talent of the Comunitat de Valencia. In 2019 Spanish Brass received the Espai Ter de Música and two Carles Santos Music Awards.

As well as participating in some of the most important festivals in the world, they performed at the gala for the Prince of Asturias Awards in 1995, and have recorded music for the play *La Fundación* by Buero Vallejo, at the Centro Dramático Nacional, as well as the score for the film *Desconégate* by Félix Sabroso produced by El Deseo.

Spanish Brass have published twenty-six recordings, among them two DVD-CDs and a double CD collection, which shows their multiple aspects.

Alongside their activities as performers, Spanish Brass organises two festivals, international in scope, devoted to brass instruments: the Festival Spanish Brass Alzira (www.sbalz.com) and the Brassurround (www.brassurround.com), where every year some of the most prestigious international brass soloists, groups and teachers gather.

Spanish Brass plays Courtois trombone and Melton tuba; and also with the new BlackBinder application.

Spanish Brass uses Bags instrument cases. In addition, they receive support from the Institut Valencià de Cultura and the Ministerio de Cultura-INAEM.
